In terms of overall activity, 2010 was consistent with 2009, which in turn was consistent with 2008. All of these are well off the pace of 2007 (107 emergency responses, 177 total responses.) 2007 was the last heavy tourism year in the north lake area, which probably accounts for the difference in activity.

Fortunately wild land fire season was a non-issue locally as well as regionally. There were two starts with any potential (one via lightning and one via negligence), both above Lake Forest Estates. CCVFD and TCVFD rendered mutual aid to USFS and both were rapidly extinguished.
